<p>English</p> <p>We will be covering a range of text types this term, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Biographies • Explanation texts • Fantasy narrative • Poetry 	<p>Maths</p> <p>We will be covering the following topics in Maths this term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number: Multiplication and Division • Number: Fractions • Number: Decimals (Including Year 5 Percentages) 	<p>Science</p> <p>We will begin the term with our new topic, Sound. We will learn to identify how sounds are made, explore how vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear and find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it.</p>
<p>Topic - Discovery and Invention</p> <p>This history topic will develop the children's knowledge and understanding of British history beyond 1066. They will learn more about how people's lives have shaped this nation and how Britain has influenced and been influenced by the wider world.</p>	<p>Art and D.T.</p> <p>Our Art and D.T. is linked to the topic for the term. We will study the history of clothing in Britain from 1066 through to the present day, learning about the key changes in fashion, materials and manufacturing processes and gain an understanding of this aspect of social history in Britain.</p>	<p>P.E.</p> <p>P.E. will start with gymnastics and dance, before moving on to basketball after the half term. Please come to school in P.E. kits on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Forest School will not take place until after the half term.</p>
<p>Music</p> <p>The class will be continuing to learn the ukulele in their Music lessons with Miss Steed, who will be introducing world music genres this term.</p>	<p>French</p> <p>Our topic is Shopping in France. We will learn to construct high numbers in French and develop food related vocabulary through games and role play.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>The topic this term is Data and Information. The class will use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data.</p>
<p>P.S.H.E. and Philosophy</p> <p>Our P.S.H.E. questions for this term will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How can we help in an accident or emergency? • How can friends communicate safely? 	<p>R.E.</p> <p>This term, our R.E. topic focuses on Judaism. We will be exploring the question: What is holiness for Jewish people: a place, a time, an object or something else? Our theme in Collective Worship begins with Trust and truthfulness.</p>	<p>Home Learning</p> <p>This term Year 4 children would benefit from a real push at home on times tables, as their Multiplication Tables check is coming up in the Summer Term.
